

The Danish designer Kasper Salto has designed the NAP™ chair for Fritz Hansen. NAP is a series of light stacking chairs designed for optimum sitting comfort regardless of the sitting position. NAP is an abbreviation of Normal, Active and Passive – because sitting is in actual fact constant movement.



KASPER SALTO

KASPER SALTO 1967-

Kasper Salto was originally trained as a cabinet maker and later graduated in 1994 from the Danish Design School. In Kasper Salto's work the Danish tradition of furniture design is continued in a well-balanced combination with international industrial design and its new trends. Salto's main source of inspiration is nature and its way of colouring. Kasper Salto has already received several design awards for his work. Salto has also designed the Ice™ series and Little Friend™.

DESCRIPTION

Series of light stacking chairs suitable for cafeterias, conference rooms, offices and the private home. Designed by Kasper Salto, manufactured by Fritz Hansen.

FINISH

NAP is available in two varieties, with and without arm rests. The back of the shell has a high-gloss surface, and the front is matt and ribbed to emphasise the geometry of the chair. To minimise undesired noise and the risk of floor marks, the front and back leg ferrules have different sizes. All varieties come in four different colours: Milk White, Butter Yellow, Pepper Grey, Coffee Brown.

The shell is moulded and dyed through in nylon (Polyamide – PA6), which allows the material to be recycled. The underside cover and the spacing blocks are made of nylon and TPE (Thermo Plastic Elastomer), respectively. Both are dyed through in the colour of the shell. The frame is made of 14 mm steel and powder coated in colours corresponding to the shell, or in chromed steel. The leg ferrules are made of black TPE.

The chair stacks 8-10 units at a time with and without arm rests.

UPHOLSTERY

NAP is also available with seat upholstery – the upholstery may also be purchased separately and mounted later or be replaced. The seat cushion is made of TPE with a velour underside and fabric or leather on top, thickness 5 mm. The cushion is available in Divina fabric from Kvadrat in a selection of ten predefined colours or Classic leather in the colours Black, Black-brown and Walnut.

ENVIRONMENTAL FRIENDLINESS AND TESTING

For environmental reasons the chair can easily be dismantled and recycled. The main chair component – nylon – is a plastics material used in our everyday lives, and the chair is therefore suitable for recycling. The plastic can be granulated, and steel parts can be recycled.

The chair has been tested and approved according to EN 1728:2000, test level 2, corresponding to normal public use.





WARRANTY




