Tool lights up the rough vintage environment of factories and workshops, with shapes and materials derived from the pull of technology in its raw state. In fact, this lamp has been designed with a single rubber body, its form reminiscent of a foundry mould or a piece of engineering straight from the lathe. Transmitted is the impression of an object fresh off the assembly line and destined for a home environment unafraid to break with design and aesthetic conventions. It has a single rubber body, and it's available in two suspension versions, large and small. The smaller is also available as a reading or table version, with a rough cement base and black varnished metal stand. All models produce precise, direct light.
